RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Religious Education Registration is now closed.

Classroom helpers and substitutes are needed for all sessions. Please contact the RE office if you can help.

As a reminder, please have your child to class on time. Sunday classes begin at 9:15am and 11am, and Monday classes begin at 5pm.

Diocesan policy is for each child to receive a minimum of 30 hours of religious education every year. Please help us to maintain that. Late arrivals and early dismissals that result less than 30 hours could impact your child from advancing to the next grade level. Individual circumstances must be discussed directly with the DRE and supplemental homework assignments will be expected.

The Arlington Diocese requires that Child Protection Programs be taught to all children in grades 1-8 in our Diocesan schools and in parish religious education programs as well as in all High School Sessions. 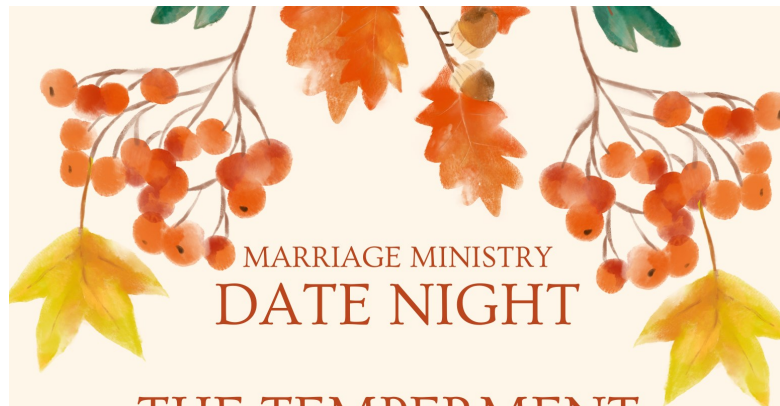

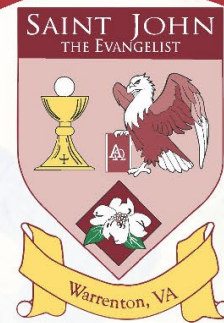
